Important Dates in 2020 Wisconsin Elections

NOW: Start date for requesting an absentee (mail) ballot.

Sept 17 Clerks may begin sending out absentee ballots to voters.

October 6 Last day for people who are moving to establish legal voting residence.

*****This is a change** (if you move between October 6 and November 3, you will need to vote from your prior residence).

October 12 First day for special deputy-assisted voting in nursing homes and care facilities.

October 14 Deadline for non-registered residents to **register** to vote BY MAIL or ONLINE prior to election day (you can still register to vote at your clerk's office or at your polling place on election day).

October 29 5 pm Deadline to request an absentee ballot (realistically probably too late to get it done by mail).

October 30 5pm Deadline for residents to **register** to vote at their clerk's office (you can still register at your polling place on November 3).

November 1 5 pm Deadline for voting in person prior to election day. NOTE: Municipalities may end in person early voting prior to this date. Voters need to check with their clerk for dates.

November 2 5 pm Deadline for special deputy-assisted voting in nursing homes and care facilities.

November 3 Election day! Polls open at 7 am and close at 8 pm. Absentee ballots must be filed so that they can be delivered to the correct polling place by 8 pm.
